

Course in Male Sexology

On behalf of the Danish Andrological Society (DAS), the Department of Growth and Reproduction, Rigshospitalet, holds a postgraduate course in Andrological Sexology.

The course will take place:

From 17th to 19th September 2015 at Rigshospitalet in Copenhagen, Denmark.

The course venue is "Room 2, at Hammershusgade 11". This is approximately 1 km from the main complex of Rigshospitalet.

Target group:

Clinicians (endocrinologists, urologists, andrologists, paediatricians, gynaecologists, general practitioners, sexologists) and researchers with interest in Male Sexology. Max. 45 participants.

Curriculum:

2½ days course in andrological sexology focusing on Male Sexological aspects. Seminars based on lectures combined with case presentations. There will be a written examination at the end of the course.

Course accreditation:

The course has been approved by European Academy of Andrology (EAA) as an educational course in Clinical Andrology for trainees aiming at an EAA certification. Five credits can be obtained.
